MISSION STATEMENT

Our Lady of Victory Cenacle affirms and develops an apostolic and prophetic baptismal call of our inter-culture community. We do this by Spiritual Formation, Reaching out to others, Creating Community and working for Social Justice with a Missionary Spirit. We seek to transform families, church, community and society.

The population of Compton has changed through the years; there are more than a hundred thousand residents. Eighty percent, of these residents are: Mexican American, and Latinos from Mexico, Central American countries and a few from South America. Twenty percent are African American.

The main social issues are: Gang members, about ten thousand young people are involve in crimes, assault, Incarceration. Other issues are: Domestic violence, drugs addiction, deportation and separation of families, due to their legal status.

We are currently strengthening the ministries in the following areas:

1. Sacrament and worship
2. Workshops for staff, pastoral counsel, and ministries
3. Religious Education (CCD programs)
4. Catholic school
5. Social services: ( Center for legal immigration, saint-Vincent Paul, adult education, free medical and dental clinic, and human development )
6. Vocations for religious life and priesthood (encouraging families to pray every Sunday and during the week)
7. Evangelization outreach ( sectors, homes, streets, hospitals and prisons)
8. Having collaboration with organizations (Mexican consulate, St. Francis hospital, Coachella Valle mission-encounter missioner for evangelization, and ACM) and local government.

The four elements: Kerigma, koinonna, didache and diakonia, so we can be aware of conversion and transformation, in order to love, serve, and teach others.

Our main emphasis is to create in the Christian community the experience of the love of God through his sacramental presence and a family environment in social and cultural activities through our pastoral groups and apostolate.

### 1. Pastoral goals for 2016-2017

A. To apply for accreditation, for the center for immigration.

B. Formation of laity with the help and resources from the organization such as; IAF/ ONE LA. In order to develop discipleship and apostleship and a practical leadership.
